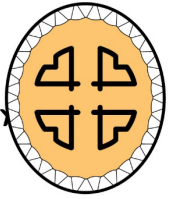

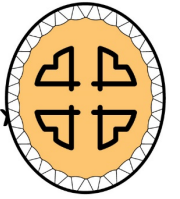
- a. **Non-essential travel, even within Eeyou Istchee, is currently not recommended by all government authorities in Canada;**

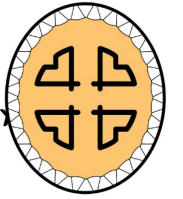
