





CREE CABIN DAMAGE ASSESSMENT REGISTRY

In response to the devastating forest fires that swept through our region during the summer of 2023, the Cree Nation Government, in collaboration with Niskamoon Corporation, the Cree Trappers' Association, and Cree communities, would like to announce the launch of the Cree Cabin Damage Assessment Registry.

These fires have left behind a trail of destruction, affecting not only the land and wildlife but also our cultural activities. Beyond the physical devastation, these events have deeply eroded cherished memories, intergenerational connections, and our cultural and historical heritage.

Recognizing the unprecedented scale and profound impact of these forest fires on our Cree Land Users and their traditional practices, we have established this centralized registry. Through this registry, those affected will be able to report the extent of damage and loss to their cabins and related equipment.


This registry will provide necessary data to assess resource needs for remediation efforts, ultimately supporting the development of a comprehensive regional strategy

- · Location of the cabin
- · How was the cabin building funded
- Cabin insurance provider if any
- List and pictures of the damaged cabin including related equipment
